What's been going on in school this week?

This week, pupils across school have continued to demonstrate excellent engagement and enthusiasm in their learning. In the Hive, children have enjoyed a range of sensory activities linked to their animal topic, with the crocodile swamp and frog pool proving particularly popular as they explored different habitats and textures. In Ducklings, pupils have continued their seaside theme, learning about British seaside resorts through a variety of activities within their areas of provision. Robins have been busy exploring ocean habitats in science, whilst also beginning work on persuasive writing in English and developing their maths skills by learning how to tell the time. In Kingfishers, pupils took part in a practical history lesson, designing and building their own Roman aqueduct before testing the construction for leaks using water. They have also continued to make excellent progress during their weekly swimming lessons. In Falcons, most Year 6 pupils spent two days visiting their new high schools as part of their transition programme, while Year 5 pupils enjoyed representing the school at a Trust event held at Parrenthorn High School.

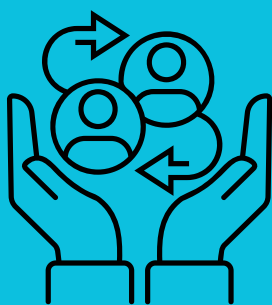

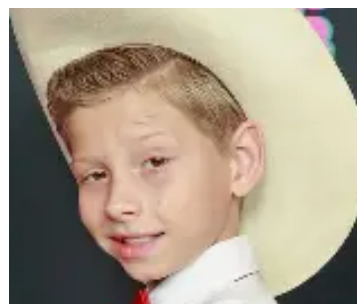

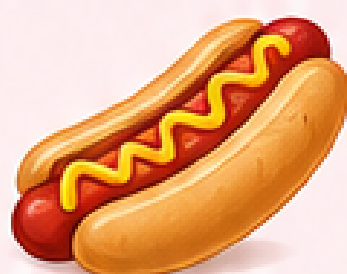
