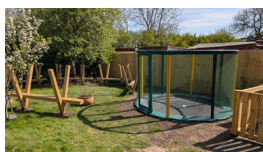


Welcome to the Summer Term

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Sun Safety

Here are a few tips to help keep your child safe during the summer months:

Dress our child in loose, cotton clothes with a floppy hat with wide brim which shades their face and neck.

Avoid the midday sun and keep babies under the age of 6 months out of direct sunlight, especially the midday sun.

Protect your child's eyes with sunglasses that meet the British Standard and carry the CE mark - read the label.

Drink plenty of fluids.

Apply sunscreen to your child before bringing them to Nursery. We have our own sunscreen here to top them up during the day.

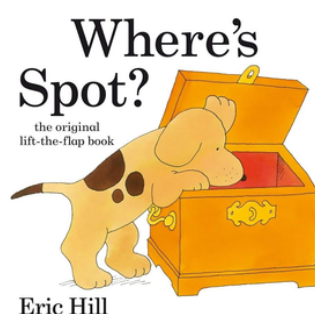
If your child has allergies to sunscreen or has sensitive skin, please let us know and you can supply your own for us to use.

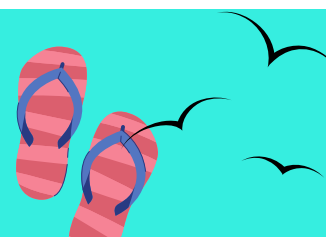
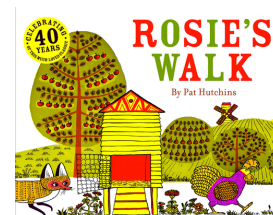
2-3's Room Key Texts
