Charging and Remission Policy

As a school we seek to meet the costs of all Educational activities undertaken by pupils from our delegated school budget provided by Durham LEA. We also raise additional money through a variety of fund-raising activities or by applying for various grants and allowances. This enables us to further improve school buildings/grounds and enhance the broader curriculum.

However, in order to enrich the curriculum further through wider experiences such as visitors/events and educational visits, we ask parents for a voluntary contribution towards the costs of valuable experiences and activities. These costs will be planned and requested in advance.

These costs are communicated to parents well before the event and parental help with the costs enable us to offer a much wider range of such activities.

No child will be excluded if they have not paid. However, the school wishes to make clear that should insufficient funds be raised to cover the costs, visits or additional curriculum activities may need to be cancelled.

Wraparound care is provided at a competitive rate for child care.

After school clubs are offered and small charge is administered for some to cover equipment, materials or the cost of external providers.

The Governing Body reserves the right to seek reparation from parents where their children cause breakages or damage to school property.
