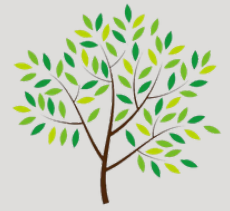

Asra (Y3) won Head's milkshake this week for having the best comment in her reading record.

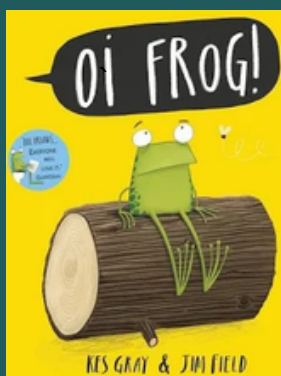
Once again, Reyah & Aliyah (Y5) won Head's hot chocolate for being polite and thinking of others. Well done girls, keep up the great work!

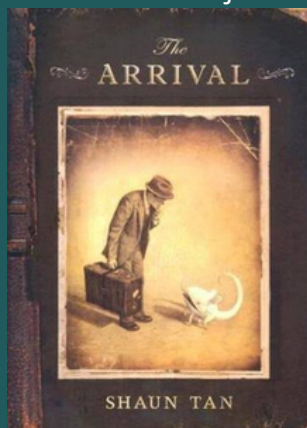


BOOK OF THE FORTNIGHT
