Ladycross Nursery Commitment

We are committed to providing a safe, nurturing, and inclusive environment where children feel happy, secure, and supported to develop through play and positive relationships.

Expectations for Children at Ladycross Nursery

Children are encouraged and supported to:

- Treat others with kindness and respect
- Take part in activities appropriate to their age and stage of development
- Follow daily routines with adult guidance
- Develop independence at their own pace

Agreement

By accepting a nursery place, parents and carers agree to support these expectations and work in partnership with the nursery team.

Expectations for Parents and Carers – Attendance at Ladycross Nursery

Parents and carers are expected to:

- Ensure children arrive on time and are collected promptly
- Inform the nursery if their child will be absent or late

Toilet Training Requirement

Children are expected to be toilet trained before joining the nursery. This means they can use the toilet independently with minimal support and do not require nappies during the nursery day.

Health and Wellbeing at Ladycross Nursery

Parents and carers must:

- Keep children at home when they are unwell
- Follow the nursery illness and exclusion policy
- Inform staff of any changes to medical or dietary needs





Ladycross Nursery Expectations

Clothing and Personal Belongings at Ladycross Nursery

- Parents and carers should ensure:
 - Children wear comfortable, practical clothing suitable for play – The uniform consists of black joggers, a white polo (with or without school logo), blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with or without school logo)
 - Clothing is appropriate for the weather
 - All items are clearly labelled
 - Children follow the no jewellery / no earrings policy
 - Do not bring toys from home
 - Dummies are not allowed on site – please do not bring into school.

Communication

We ask parents and carers to:

- Share relevant information about their child's needs or routines
- Read and respond to nursery communications
- Treat staff and other families with respect

Safeguarding and Site Safety

To support safeguarding, parents and carers must:

- Ensure only authorised adults collect children
- Follow all nursery safety procedures

Behaviour and Conduct at Ladycross Nursery

We expect all adults on site to:

- Act respectfully towards staff, children, and other families
- Raise concerns calmly and privately with staff or management
- Follow nursery policies and procedures
