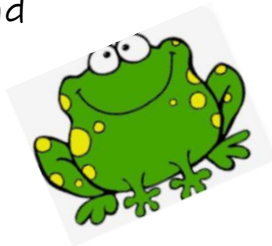
## Here is the Beehive
