The boys and girls have been working on a very special surprise for their grown-ups. Their cards will be posted on the 15th of December (remember to act surprised when they arrive!)

We will be talking about the Postman and Postwoman that deliver letters to our school. As post arrives at your house over Christmas use this as a learning opportunity to talk about:

- The job of a postman/woman.
- The different sizes of cards arriving (mathematical language)
- The writing on a letter (point out the address).
- Your house number.
- Where you live (Fivemiletown, Clabby, Tempo, Brookeborough).

Christmas cards are a fantastic resource to develop cutting skills- after Christmas draw shapes around the pictures (squares, rectangles, circles) in black marker and support your child as they cut them out.
