Introduction

The school has an attractive and vibrant uniform which has been chosen in part by parents and children. We believe our school uniform provides a strong sense of identity and sense of belonging to a community. **All children are expected to wear the correct uniform.** Much of the uniform is available on the high street. However, some items are only available from the school website ordering service - mapac. Their website can be accessed through the school website

We have been mindful when choosing our uniform that it can all be sourced at a reasonable cost. The school regularly benchmarks the cost of its school uniform to ensure it is reasonably priced. Pre-owned uniform is also available free of charge from the school office or from the PTA for a small donation.

Labelling clothing

All uniform should be clearly labelled with your child's name. In the event that clothing is mislaid, if it has a name it will be returned to the wearer. Everything else is placed in the lost property box in the lower playground foyer. This box is cleared

at the end of each long term; items are placed on tables in the playground for collection. Items not collected are donated to a clothing collection charity.

Jewellery and Hair

Items of jewellery are unsuitable for primary school pupils to wear during the school day. Rings, necklaces, brooches and earrings should be left at home. A number of pupils have pierced ears. Please ensure that these pupils wear only small studs to school. Earrings can be dangerous for the wearer, and for other children, if they catch them during physical activity, particularly P.E. and Games. Any other piercing is not permitted e.g. nose and eyebrow. Hair that is shoulder length or longer (on girls or boys) needs to be tied back or secured with an Alice band for health and safety reasons. **Small hair bands, scrunches and slides should be green, yellow, grey or black.**

Monitoring

The school carries out regular uniform and PE uniform checks. Children who fail to wear the correct uniform will be sent home with a letter. If the correct uniform fails to be worn on a number of occasions, parents will be called to a meeting with the Head of School. The school will support families who are struggling with the cost of uniform by providing good quality pre-worn uniform.

The Uniform

Boys

- ◆ A jade green sweatshirt or cardigan*
- ◆ A gold polo shirt, worn under the sweatshirt or alone in warmer weather*
- ◆ Dark grey trousers (**grey jogging bottoms can be worn by Foundation Stage pupils only**).
- ◆ Grey or black school shoes. **We understand that trainers are often a popular choice for footwear but if worn, these shoes must be majority black in colour.** Other coloured footwear is not acceptable. Sandals with backs can be worn in warm weather. These need to be a neutral colour. Crocs or jelly shoes are not permitted.

In the summer the boys have the option of wearing grey short trousers

Girls

- ◆ A jade green sweatshirt or cardigan*
- ◆ A gold polo shirt, worn under the sweatshirt or alone in warmer weather*
- ◆ A dark grey skirt or dark grey trousers (**grey jogging bottoms can be worn by Foundation Stage pupils only**).
- ◆ Grey tights, grey or white socks. Grey, black or white leggings may be worn under skirts or dresses.
- ◆ Grey or black school shoes. **We understand that trainers are often a popular**

choice for footwear but if worn, these shoes must be majority black in colour.
Sandals with backs or white shoes can be worn in warm weather. These need to be A neutral colour.

- ◆ If headscarves are worn they need to be in the following colours: jade, gold or grey.

In the summer the girls have the option of wearing either a yellow or jade green gingham summer dress.

Outer wear

- ◆ All children need a **waterproof** winter coat. Some school coats are available on the website. Hooded tops are NOT permitted.
- ◆ School winter hats and gloves are available on the website.
- ◆ In the summer children can wear a lightweight summer jacket. It is advisable to have a hood. Some school jackets are available on the website.
- ◆ Summer caps and hats are available on the website.
- ◆ Whilst boots can be worn in winter. **These need to be plain black.** Ugg boots and similar fashion boots are NOT permitted.

School Bags

◆ All children should have a school bag and a yellow PE bag. School bags are available on the website. There are several school bag options:

- Dark green rucksacks - available in 2 sizes
- Dark green lightweight infant back pack
- Yellow book bag

Parents can choose to provide children with a non-school logo bag. This should still be a rucksack.

PE Uniform

- ◆ White t-shirt - these can be plain or with the school logo
- ◆ Navy blue shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings
- ◆ Black plimsolls or plain black trainers

Swimming (children go swimming in Year 3, 4 and 5)

Boys

- ◆ Swimming trunks. Baggy shorts are NOT permitted
- ◆ Goggles are optional
- ◆ Swimming hat (optional unless hair is mid length or longer)

Girls

- ◆ Swimming Costume. Bikinis/Tankinis are NOT permitted
- ◆ Swimming hat
- ◆ Goggles are optional

*These items bear the school logo and are not available from high street retailers (see above). However, a plain dark yellow polo shirt can be worn in place of a polo shirt with logo.

Dark Grey Trousers and Skirts - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets (THESE MUST BE DARK GREY).

Grey Jogging Bottoms (NURSERY and RECEPTION PUPILS ONLY) - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets (most stockists only stock light or mid grey jogging bottom, both are acceptable).

Grey tights, grey or white socks. Grey, black or white leggings can also be worn under skirts or dresses. These need to be worn with appropriate socks - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets.

Yellow Summer Dresses or Skort dresses - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets.

Jade Green Summer Dresses or Skort dresses - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets.

Black School Shoes - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets.

PE Uniform

White t-shirt - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets.

Navy blue shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets.

Black plimsolls or plain trainers - these can be purchased from most high street shops and larger supermarkets.

Pre-owned Uniform

We have a good range of pre-owned uniform available from either the school office or through the PTA. This is a great way to save a little money and to help support our reuse and recycle policy.
