#### DLD Awareness Day at All Souls Primary


Last Friday, our pupils took part in a range of fun activities to celebrate **DLD**Awareness Day and learn more about 
Developmental Language Disorder (DLD).

We started by watching a PowerPoint all about DLD and how it affects communication. Then, children became **DLD Detectives**, searching the school for DLD facts hidden on purple and yellow papers made with InPrint.

Each class wrote the facts they found on coloured paper strips and joined them together to create beautiful **paper chains**.
