Parents: a guide to summer holidays online

Simple conversations. Safer
sharing. Positive online habits.



1 Sit down together

Visit favourite sites and games together; show interest in their online lives; start positive conversations so they feel confident talking to you if something upsets them.



2 Social media and staying in touch

Ask which sites and games they use; check age requirements; encourage privacy tools or posts are shared only with people they know and trust.



3 Talking about time online

Use conversation starters, watch or read age-appropriate online safety activities, and encourage good choices about sharing images and videos.



4 Sharing holiday pictures

Talk about what is okay to share and who it is okay to share with. Remember photos can reveal clues like landmarks or street signs; always ask children before posting images of them.



5 Make a family agreement

Create family promises together about how everyone behaves online at home, at school, and at friends' houses.

We are very proud of the smart appearance of the children at St John's. Our uniform policy reflects the high expectations we have as a school.

Grey school style trousers, skirt, pinafore dress (*where girls prefer to wear trousers these must be grey and regular fitting or boot cut in style (leggings or skinny fit trousers are not permitted)*)

Grey socks, bottle green or dark grey tights, or white socks

Hair accessories must be dark green, black or white.

Children should not wear make-up, nail varnish or tattoos to school.

With the exception of the St John's sweatshirts and cardigans (with the school logo) **which are compulsory** and can only be ordered from PMG Schoolwear, all other items can be purchased from a range of high street stores and

supermarkets.

Children are required to wear black school style shoes. (Trainers, ballet pumps, open-toed shoes and boots are not permitted)

In the winter months children should have black tracksuit bottoms/leggings and a grey or black sweatshirt in school for outside P.E. lessons.

It is essential that all clothing is named. Where particular sports are played during the year, additional items may be required for health and safety reasons e.g., shin pads for older children.

Scooters and Bicycles in School

Please could all parents remind children that scooters and bicycles ARE NOT to be ridden on school grounds, they must be dismounted at the school gate and walked in.

We had an incident last week where a grandparent who had come to collect at pick up was knocked into by a child riding a scooter and this resulted in a nasty fall which needed a visit to the hospital.

It has also come to our attention that there have been several 'near misses' between cars and children on bikes and scooters and, concerningly, there have been occasions where children have been without a helmet. We want to encourage all parents to speak to their children about the seriousness of road and cycling safety, and how crucial it is for all children to be wearing helmets when they are cycling and scooting.

If there are any families who are struggling to source helmets for their children, please reach out to Alaina Tabern (Child and Family Support Worker) who can support with signposting to other agencies who may be able to help secure cycling safety equipment. 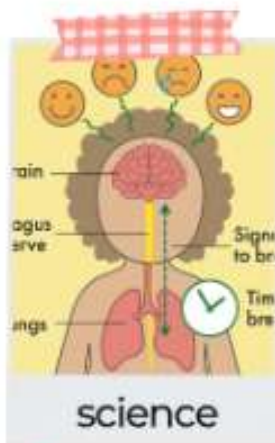
