




Christmas Card Competition

Please also note that lateness is also recorded and I would encourage all parents and careres to be punctual each morning. More than 30 children are regularly late to school. They miss their extremly important phonics or reading session as for most classes this is during the entry period.

Brent Dental Health Care

As you know Northwest London has some of the highest rates of poor dental health among children in the UK. The NHS with Brent LA have prioritised improving oral health and access to dental care as a system wide issue. They are running a project to encourage children who live in NW10 or HA9 who do not have a dentist, or who do not regularly go to see a dentist, to take up the offer to book an appointment at one of the following dental practices.
