# Oral Health Dental Bus Initiative Thursday 26th June Infant Hall 3-5 p.m. Save the date

As you may be aware, Brent is experiencing high rates of poor oral health in its children. In fact, at 46%, Brent is the borough with the highest percentage of children with decayed, missing or filled teeth at five years of age, nationwide.

As part of efforts to tackle this statistic, over the last four years, Brent Public Health team have delivered the "Oral Health Bus" initiative. This involved visiting parks, recreational areas and schools with dentists who would carry out dental checks for children and make referrals for onward care. The programme is a huge success, with over 1500 children benefitting from the programme.

A week prior to the event, we will send you a booking link to book a slot to see the team of dentists who will be on site after school, but children will also be seen as walk-ins if you do not manage to book a slot.

On the day of the event a team of dental professionals will carry out checks on children, applying fluoride varnish and making referrals where needed. Other healthcare professionals including the asthma nurse, the healthy eating team and libraries will also be in attendance to provide general health and wellbeing advice.

This is a fantastic opportunity to improve the oral and overall health of the pupils at our school and an opportunity that should not be missed as we are so lucky to be hosting this for our community.

#### Bling Up Your Bike or Sparkle Up Your Scooter Day

On Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> June we will have a special cycle and scoot to school day. We are encouraging the children to decorate their bike or scooter. There will be prizes for each key stage for the scooter/bike that has been decorated the most creatively.


