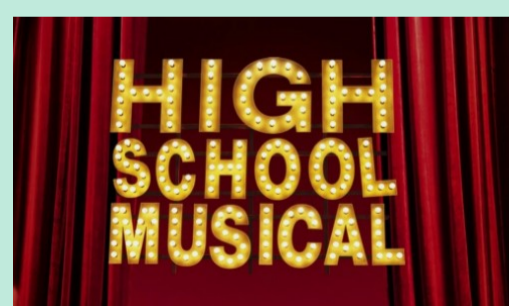
## Dig Day
