# Updates from the Head

**Welcome back** - and an especially warm welcome to the new children, families and staff joining us! It has been lovely seeing the children coming into school with smiles on their faces. We are all very impressed with the positive attitudes they have shown both in class and around school.

I continue to split my time equally across the school sites. Mrs Peers is Teacher-in-Charge and Deputy Safeguarding Lead when I'm not on site and is also able to help with any issues arising in my absence. However, should you ever need to speak to me urgently, I can be contacted via either school office.

After discussion with staff and children, we have made a change to how Forest Schools runs: it will now be on weekly rotation for each class. This has allowed Mrs Harrison to plan learning opportunities that relate purposefully to our wider curriculum and, more importantly, means the children can develop their bushcraft skills throughout all seasons.
