English

Reading

Our text this term is Finding Bear by Hannah Gold.

Writing

Children will write a narrative extract, linking to Finding Bear. They will building on previous skills linked to narrative writing, using a range of devices to help build cohesion and direct speech.

We will then explore balanced arguments and their features before writing our own, linked to our wider curriculum learning.

Maths

This half term children will be looking at decimals and fractions. Children will also consolidate arithmetic and reasoning and problem solving skills linked to this.
