Core subjects this half term

English **Reading**

Our class text this half term is Windrush Child by Benjamin Zephaniah.

Writing

Children will write a historical recount, based on the Windrush. They will explore using the active and passive voice, the subjunctive mood and relative clauses and devices to help build cohesion. We will then explore writing formal letters and persuasive arguments.

Maths

This half term children will be looking at multiplication and division as well as fractions. Children will also consolidate arithmetic and reasoning and problem solving skills linked to this.
