Core subjects this half term

English

Reading

Our class text this half term is *The Extraordinary Colours* of Auden Dare by Zillah Bethell.

Writing

Children will explore two forms: a narrative that is written from the perspective of a main character; and a persuasive letter written in a formal tone to figure of authority.

Grammar will focus on embedding skills surrounding speech and dialogue: the characterisation of characters and advancing action. Additionally, they will aim to perfect the use of subjunctive form and passive voice.

This half term children will consolidate their knowledge of calculation focusing on multiplication, division and fractions in preparation for Year 6.
