Lunch Orders

Previously, as you might already be aware, if there was more than £5 owing for a child's lunches, it is our caterer's policy that a 'welfare meal' of soup and a roll will be served for that child regardless of the item they actually ordered. Unfortunately, this system is not working well as the office is not notified by the kitchen staff until meals are about to be served making it difficult to get this resolved with parents in time for lunch.

During the Easter Break, Relish's system will be updated so that parents will not be able to place lunch orders if there is insufficient credit on the child's account to pay for that meal. As ParentPay and the relish system do not communicate in 'real time', updates are run at 8:00pm each evening; sufficient credit will need to be in place by that time.

These changes will mean that meal orders will only be placed in school in an emergency situation, when the office is notified by the parent. Otherwise if no meal has been ordered for a child and they do not have a packed lunch with them, you will receive a call requesting that you drop off a packed lunch for them before 12:00.

Also, on occasions, children have asked their teachers to change the order placed at home. Teachers have been instructed not to amend orders placed at home and will ask the child to speak to their parents about the choices made. We strongly encourage you to allow your child to choose with you when you are placing the order, so that they are involved the process. And avoid this situation.

Key changes/information to note:

- * **Parents will not be able to place meal orders if there is insufficient credit on the child's account for that meal.**
- * **Credit for the meal must be in place by 8pm the evening before, in order to update balances on Relish.**
- * **Meals will not be ordered or amended in the classroom.**
- * **In an emergency situation, parents must contact the office directly.**
- * **If there is no lunch order for a child and they do not have a packed lunch with them, parents will be called and asked to bring in a packed lunch by 12:00.**
