Relish

This is the same as with Wrap-Around bookings. As charge is made for all meals booked, so please remember to cancel any that you no longer want

Please can the parents of children in years R to 2 make sure that any school lunch orders are cancelled if your child is bringing a packed lunch from home as school will still be charged for all meals prepared. Also, please remember that if you book a 'packed lunch' on Relish, this is a school meal (not packed lunch from home) and you also need to choose the appropriate filling.

Secondary School Application Deadline Reminder - LCC Communications Team We are now just a few weeks away from the deadline for secondary school applications. Please help us remind parents and carers of children currently in year 6 they need to submit their application by Thursday 31st October 2025.

Key reminders for families:

- Applications must be made through the Parent Portal on the Leicestershire County Council website.
- Families should include at least three preferences, and up to five, to give their child the best chance of securing a local school place.
- At least one preference should be for their catchment school.
- Simply selecting one school does not improve a child's chances of securing a place there.
- Parents should make sure they are happy with the order of preference before the deadline.

Applications close at 11.59pm on Thursday 31st October 2025. Any applications submitted after this date will be treated as late and processed after those received on time.
