Science Week

This year for Science Week, our BeSkilled group of schools took part in a brilliant project all about curiosity. Each school thought of an investigation question for another school to explore in their own creative way. The questions were swapped, investigated during Science Week, and then the findings were sent back to the original school to share what had been discovered. It was such a fun way to connect our schools and celebrate scientific thinking together.

Our school's curiosity question to investigate was, "How do birds make their nests?". This inspired lots of exciting learning across our classes, with children exploring different materials, building their own nests and carrying out experiments to see how strong and waterproof they could make them. There was plenty of creativity, teamwork and thoughtful discussion as the children worked like real scientists. We are so proud of the enthusiasm and curiosity shown by everyone involved.
