#### Reminder about break-time snacks.

There has been an increase over the last few weeks of snacks being consumed that do not fit the criteria of a healthy snack e.g. fruit, cereal bar. Children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 receive a piece of school fruit each day. Please also remember we are a nut free school.

#### School Lunch Price increase from January.

In the autumn term we held off any price increase that was due on school meals as we transitioned from LTS Catering to Relish. However due to the increase in food costs and the increase in the living wage for staff we write to notify you that from the start of the Spring term the cost of school dinners will increase from  $\pounds 2.50$  per meal by 10p taking the cost of paid meals to  $\pounds 2.60$  per meal. ParentPay and Relish will show the new price from the start of next term.


There is also a new menu launching from January which is attached to the newsletter and on the school website.




