If this is likely to affect your journeys to and from school please ensure that you leave in plenty of time to make it here for the start/end of the school day.

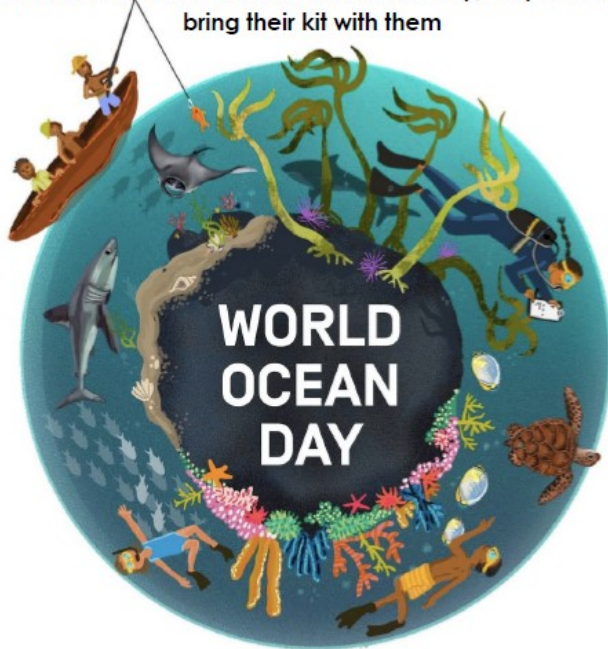
World Ocean Day - Monday 8th June 2026

Staying Sun Safe

This is a reminder of what parents agree to when their children start with us. All parents have agreed to this, apart from certain children who can only wear the sunscreen provided by their parents.

We ask that when the sun is strong during the warmer months that you apply long lasting sun block before they come to school and send them with their own sun block to re-apply if needed. We do have sun cream in school in case the child's cream has been forgotten

In-line with our Sun Protection Policy we ask that parents ensure their child(ren) are equipped with a suitable sun hat and sunscreen (that they can apply themselves) that are clearly labelled and brought to school for use/application each day during the summer months and ask that sunscreen is also applied before the children come to school each day.
