### Abaana New Life Children's Choir

On the evening of April 21st (Sunday) Breedon Priory Church is hoping to hold a concert by the Abaana New Life Children's choir from Uganda who are currently in the UK.

In order to do this, we need to find about eight hosts who could put up an adult chaperone (in a single room) and 2-3 children either in beds or on mats/mattresses on the floor. So far we have just two hosts, so we are not yet sure whether the concert can go ahead.

Apparently the children's concert is brilliant, so I'm told. There are about 20 young singers from Uganda.

Abaana Ministries is a mission agency based in Northern Ireland, committed to children's education in Africa. You can read about their work and the choir's ministry at www.abaana.org/choir. Locally, they are supported both by Breedon Priory Church and Staunton Harold Church.
