It is not necessarily for parents of ongoing cases where actions are being taken as they will already have detailed communication with her but any initial worries or concerns. As part of the Autism Central programme, Daisy Chain provides virtual support sessions to help support individuals and families.

These free, online, sessions are an opportunity for parents/carers of autistic and neurodivergent children to connect with each other and get advice from the Autism Central team.

This group is suitable for you if you have a child who is diagnosed / going through the diagnostic process / has been identified by a professional as having a need relating to: autism, ADHD, FASD, Sensory processing differences, anxiety and social and communication differences.

at Ripon Workhouse Museum every Monday during term time, 4:30 to 6 pm, £2.00 per session


