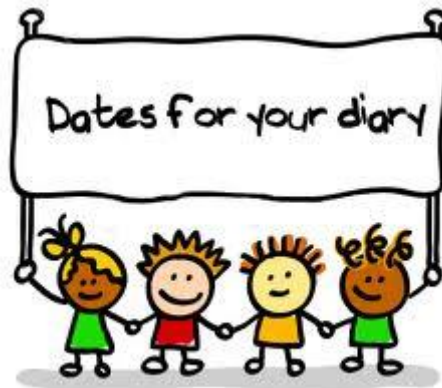

## **Year 3**

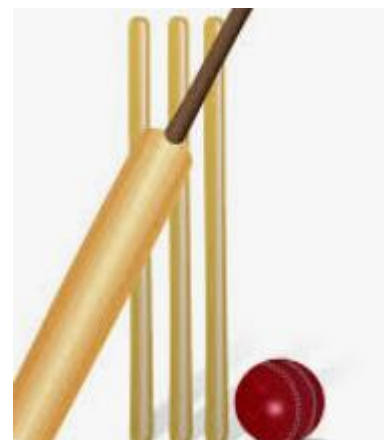
