


March 6th 2026

This week at Harewood

Turquoise Class have enjoyed using their imagination this week and have thought about what it would be like to travel into space; Year One thought about what the moon would be like and wrote interesting descriptions, and Reception imagined going on a rocket journey with their favourite teddies and toys. In maths, Year One have begun a new multiplication topic and Reception have been practising their early addition skills. They all enjoyed PE this week as they were introduced to the game of golf - by the end of the lesson they all looked very professional with their putting position. They have also been geographers and have explored the different types of weather we experience here in the UK. This week in **Blue Class** the Year 1 children have been using descriptive words in English to describe the moon and wrote about what they would take on a trip to the moon. The Reception children have again been using their phonic knowledge to write simple words and sentences. In geography, the children learned about the first balloon flight around the world and discussed the route taken to show their knowledge of the hot and cold parts of the world. In PE, the children



started to learn how to play golf by putting; it took a lot of concentration and resilience to keep trying but the children did very well. In maths, the Reception children have been composing and decomposing numbers using the part, part, whole model whilst the Year 1 children have been multiplying numbers by counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. In **Lilac Class** this week, the children have been playing golf! In PE, the children learned how to hold a golf club correctly and they practised putting the golf ball towards a target. Miss Fyfe was very impressed with their hard work and perseverance! In maths, Reception children have been finding one more and one less and they had lots of fun playing a game where people got on and off the bus. Year 1 have been finding quarters of shapes and then they went on to think about how we can

find quarters of numbers. All the children have been doing some excellent writing this week - they've been trying to write as neatly as they can and to include all the sounds they can hear within words - well done Lilac Class!

This week in **Yellow Class**, the children learned and retold 'The Moon Landing' story. In their writing, Year One wrote descriptions of the moon using exciting adjectives. They also wrote about what they would take with them if they were to visit the moon. We are very impressed with how independent the Reception children are in their writing tasks and we can see how hard they are working to use all the sounds that they know. In history, we learned about what life was like when the Montgolfier Brothers were around and in geography, we discussed the first round the world balloon flight, plotting the route taken on a world map. In science, we were exploring and experimenting with materials to see which are waterproof. In **Green Class** this week, Year One's have continued their maths work comparing the capacity and volume of different containers. Reception learned about the equals sign and started to do addition and subtraction of numbers up to 10 using cubes. We read the story *Whatever Next* and Year One wrote a description of the moon and what they would pack if they were going to visit the moon. In music, we clapped in time to our pirate song. In geography, we learned about hot and cold areas around the world and looked at maps, atlases and globes. We had fun in our first golf PE lesson, putting the ball onto the velcro circle!



This week in **Red Class**, the children wrote wonderful stories about *Katie and her Sea Adventure*. They carefully described their ocean settings and even used AI to help create and visualise them. In art, we drew beautiful daffodils using oil pastels and explored ocean-themed artwork. In RE, we learnt about the Easter story and created lovely tissue paper collages. Everyone also had a fantastic time visiting the Black Country Museum, where we learnt lots about transport in the past. In writing in **Orange Class** this week, the children wrote their own imaginative stories inspired by *Katie's Sea Adventure*, using exciting vocabulary and creative ideas. In maths, they have been learning all about money, practising how to recognise coins and notes and solve simple problems. In DT, the children explored and designed their own flag for a chosen explorer, thinking carefully about colours and symbols. The children thoroughly enjoyed their school trip to the Black Country Living Museum, where they experienced what life was like in the past. This week in **Pink Class**, we explored personal space and touch in PSHE, discussing what is okay and who we can talk to if we have any worries. In art, we created observational drawings of daffodils using a range of materials. In English, we reinvented the story *Katie at the Seaside*, and in maths, we compared the properties of 3D shapes. We also enjoyed a fantastic trip to the Black Country Living Museum, where we experienced what life was like in the past and visited a traditional school. Mrs Davey was told off for wearing nail varnish, and Mrs Yates got the cane for spending her money at the sweet shop!
