
From tiny acorns, mighty oak trees grow \$\infty\$



Dear Parents/Carers

We have enjoyed seeing the children and their families again as they have returned to school this week for the start of the new academic year. Sixty new reception pupils have officially joined the school, continuing their transition into school this week with half class, half day visits, which build up throughout next week, culminating in their attending full-time from Thursday (11 September).

Following the availability of handful of in-year spaces in other year groups, we have also welcomed two new pupils into Year 2 and Year 6.
