Derbyshire Libraries would like to invite all pupils to take part in this year's Summer Reading Challenge. This year's theme is Story Garden – Adventures in Nature and the Great Outdoors. The Story Garden theme will provide plenty of opportunities for children to explore their imagination and experience adventures in nature and the great outdoors through the power of reading. The challenge is delivered in partnership with libraries and designed to ensure that primary school children keep up their reading skills over the summer, as well as providing much-needed entertainment.

Children can sign up at their local library any time throughout the summer, from Saturday 5 July 2025, with the challenge being to read 6 or more library books. They will collect up to 6 stickers and once they have collected them all they will have completed the challenge and receive a medal and certificate.

School Crossing Patrol Vacancy

There is a vacancy for a school crossing patrol on Maple Avenue which serves both Ripley Infant and Ripley Junior School.

Details of the School Crossing Patrol vacancy for potential applicants are as follows:

Hours of Work: 08.25 to 09.05 and 15.10 to 15.50 (1 hour 20mins per day) 6 hours 40 mins per week. Term time only

Rate of Pay: £12.23 / hour

Provision: Full training on site upon starting and continuing until the trainee feels confident to stand alone. 1 day annual training, (various topics including Safeguarding) at a local venue – paid. (Usually in November at a venue close to the SCP and between approx. 10am and 1.30pm)

Full Uniform/Kit for all seasons provided.
