Spotlight on Learning: A Look Inside Our Classrooms This Term



Willow Class invited Wise Owls Pre-School children for a Stay and Play session this week, as an opportunity to make new friends with the children who may be joining our school next year! They had a lovely afternoon together, where Willow Class showed them around the class, explored in continuous provision and taught Wise Owls all about the Lacock Vision. We are excited for the next Stay and Play, where Willow Class will be visiting Wise Owls!







Beech Class's are learning all about Cricket in PE this term, with lessons led by a coach from Chance to Shine, who is also leading lunchtime and after school clubs. This week, they learnt how to hold and use the cricket bat correctly, and developed fielding skills too during an exciting game at the end of the lesson!









Oak Class are becoming graphic designers in their Computing lessons, learning how to create vector drawings! Vector drawings are drawings made on a computer using lines and shapes which are put together to form an image. They are often used for logos and we can find them all around us! They learnt how to use https://docs.google.com/drawings to create and save vector drawings of buildings to a class account, which they can come back to and edit later. We learnt how to create shapes and lines (called objects) and manipulate them, move them, change their colour and size to create pictures.

We were very lucky again this year to be able to hold our fantastic **Bonfire and Fireworks Night** at Owl Lodge last week. Laock Parish Council Petition: Pedestrian Safety

A message from Lacock Parish Council: "Wilts Council's action has placed School children at increased risk when entering/leaving school walking between parked cars directly onto the highway; emergency evacuation of school via their main gate can no longer be relied on. Pedestrians with mobility issues, wheelchairs, children's buggies etc. can no longer safely access facilities and amenities they need; they are also at increased risk when entering/leaving their residences. There is now also an increased likelihood of vehicles parking close to building accesses obstructing customers and emergency services, obstructing light and increasing pollution into homes.


