



KS1 Girls Football Event – Tuesday 30th June 2026

We have been invited to take a group of girls to a fun based football event at Boston Spa Academy on Tuesday 30th June 2026. The event will be delivered by the Leeds Well School Partnership and female young leaders from local secondary schools. All activities will be non-competitive and are for girls who have an interest in football but do not play for a local team.

The children will travel to and from the event by minibus (along with school staff), leaving school at approximately 12.15pm and returning at approximately 3.45pm. All children will be able to eat school dinner or their usual packed lunch before leaving for the event and can take their school water bottles with them to the venue.

INSPIRE AND ENGAGE - These events will have an emphasis on participation. The aim is to inspire participants to continue their physical activity journey and lead activities when they return to school.

DEVELOP AND PLAY - These events will have an emphasis on personal development. The aim is for participants to learn and develop new skills.
