Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to provide you with important information and guidance ahead of this week's Junior Warrior events, as the weather forecast predicts warm conditions. The Junior Warrior course is approximately 3km in length. The route includes woodland shade, stream crossings, and water obstacles. Children will have plenty of opportunities to cool off and take breaks in shaded areas.

Organisers will monitor the weather closely and may make minor adjustments to the event, such as reducing the running distance in open fields if necessary. Our priority is the safety and wellbeing of all children.

To help ensure all children stay safe and comfortable, please:

- Provide your child with a water bottle.
- Apply sun cream to your child before they arrive at school.
- Ensure your child wears suitable clothing for warm weather (lightweight, breathable, and appropriate for physical activity).
- Remind your child to inform a teacher immediately if they feel unwell during the event.

Additional Safety Measures

- There will be water available at the finish line and extra water stations along the course.
- St John Ambulance will be present throughout the event.
- Children may walk any section of the course, and all obstacles are optional—participation at each stage is at their discretion.
- Event organisers will speed up registration and launch schools promptly to minimise sun exposure.

If you do not wish for your child to participate in the event, please speak to a member of staff as soon as possible so we can make alternative arrangements.

If you have any questions or would like further information, please do not hesitate to contact us. Your child's safety and enjoyment are our top priorities. Thank you for your support and cooperation.
