# Attendance

Our attendance has dropped to 94.1% from September to October half term. Please ensure that children are attending as much as possible and are only off if they are too ill to attend.

90% attendance is classed as persistent absence and it is the equivalent of a missed month in a school year. This can lead to large gaps in knowledge that can be hard to close.

# <u>Autumn Term 2 Learning</u>

This half term each class will have a focus on Geography.

<u>Early Years</u> - The children in the Early Years class will be learning about 'Awesome Autumn' and this will transition in 'Wonderful Winter'.
