



### Attendance

As we begin 2026, we want to remind parents/carers how important attendance is for all our pupils. Every day your child is not in school, they are missing valuable learning time to develop and apply their skills. The table below outlines the impact of regular absence on the children's learning.

	Attendance Percentages	Actual attendance out of a possible 190 days	Whole days absent	Learning hours lost
Good	96% - 100%	182 - 190 days	0 - 8 days	0 - 40 hours
Acceptable but some concern	93% - 95%	176 - 180 days	10 - 14 days	50 - 70 hours

Unsatisfactory serious concern	Below 90%	170 days	20 days	100 hours plus 5 for every days absence
