School Organisation Proposal: Amalgamate two schools (by discontinuance and enlargement).

Dear Parents, Carers, Staff and other stakeholders,

I am writing to inform you of proposals that Birmingham City Council is developing in close collaboration with the leadership and governing bodies of Beeches Infant School and Beeches Junior School (the Schools):

- · Discontinue Beeches Infant School:
- Enlarge Beeches Junior School
- Alter the age range of Beeches Junior School to 4 11 year olds
- Implementation 1st September 2026

The Statutory Consultation period ("representation period") will run from 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025 to 9<sup>th</sup> October. The council invites all interested people to comment on the proposal during this period.
