TikTok

It has been reported in the media that TikTok's algorithms for children's accounts contain indecent material, meaning that your children can be exposed to such content no matter what they are attempting to look at. The age requirement for TikTok and any other social media platform is 13 years old, so this shouldn't apply to any of our children. However, we are aware that some children are given permission by their parents to access such platforms. Therefore, we strongly request that if your child does use social media, TikTok in particular, you are extra vigilant as to what they are being exposed to.
