Beeches Busy Kids Club

A notice for parents/carers of children who attend our before and after school club:

Sessions must be booked in advance and paid for on School Money before your child can attend a session. The only exception to this is those who pay by childcare vouchers; please contact Mrs Gillespie in advance to book your sessions and notify when payments have been made. Please note the following:

- Bookings or cancellations must be made by 11.59pm on the night before the session at the latest.
- We may be able to take last minute after school club bookings before 12noon, by telephoning the school office. However, this will be subject to availability on the day.
- We have had an increase in bookings recently. Therefore, due to ratios and limits on spaces we may have to refuse admission if your child has not been booked in to club. From next Monday, we will be contacting parents/carers who have not booked if their children arrive at a session and we may request for you to collect them.
- If there are any outstanding breakfast or after school club debts, your child will not be able to attend club.
- Children should be brought to the door when dropping off for breakfast club and not dropped off in the carpark or further down the driveway.
- Parents/carers are not permitted to drive past the barriers to drop off or collect their child from club unless there is a prior agreement with Mrs Flint or Mr Smart. Thank you for your co-operation.
