- When we are evacuating, please let us get to our safe place with all the children before you take your child. We had a few people ask to take their child while we were walking up. When we are on our way, our total focus needs to be on keeping the children safe.
- We have heard reports of parents/carers from some of the schools posting the children's location on social media. In the unlikely event of someone wanting to harm us, posting the children's location could put your child at risk. If you are passing information on to another parent/carer, please do so privately.


