Dear Parents and Carers,

We've made it! The coach is booked! Plans are underway!

This year, we have managed to gain an incredible 6,500 ASPIRE points. To celebrate this fantastic achievement, we have organised for the whole school to go to... **a mystery location!** The children would like to build the suspense and keep the information a surprise. This year the house captains have given lots of ideas about where they would like to visit and we have been able to secure a spot at one of their suggestions!

On **Wednesday 15th July**, the whole school will be going on a trip as a reward for working together to achieve our ASPIRE Point Target.

The children will need to come into school at their usual time. We will return to school before 3pm so that we are ready for the end of the day.

On the day of the trip, children should wear their Andoversford PE Kit and a comfortable pair of closed shoes, for example a pair of trainers. Please make sure that your child has a waterproof jacket with them in case of bad weather. Sun hats, water bottles, sun cream are advisable depending on the weather. They do not know this information yet so please do not share it with them until the house captains have given out this clue.

All children will need to bring a packed lunch and a named water bottle in a small rucksack. A packed lunch can be provided by Caterlink, however this must be pre-booked in advance, **before Monday 29th June 2026**. The school have subsidised the cost of the travel of this visit to ensure that it is affordable to everybody. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£8.50 per child** to help towards the cost of the activity. Your child will not be denied a place if you decline to make a voluntary
