Dear parent/carer,

As I am sure you are aware, internet safety of children across the UK has been in the news recently and continues to be a concern.

We know that the best protection we can give to young people is knowledge of the dangers so that they are aware and can protect themselves, as well as letting them know where they can go for help and support with regards to Cyber Bullying.

In order to do this, our Year 4 pupils will be visiting a performance of an interactive play on **Tuesday 24th March** at Charlton Kings Junior School. The children will leave school by coach at 13:15 and will be back before the end of the school day. The play will tackle some of the issues around Safe Internet Use, Cyber Bullying and prevention of exploitation. The performance is age appropriate and is called **In the Net**. It will last for approximately 50 minutes and pupils will be provided with a support pack at the end of the production.

There is a voluntary contribution of £7.50 for this trip to help cover the transport costs, which the school have already subsidised.

This activity is part of a programme of work around raising and tackling the complex nature of Internet Use and is being supported by the Education Sub Group of the Gloucestershire Safeguarding Children Partnership (GSCP).

We hope that this will be a memorable way to enhance their safe internet usage and help our young people to stay safe on-line.
