School Food united Price increase & Ordering NEW Summer Term Menus

Please be advised as of next September our school meals will be increasing to £2.65 per meal this will be a weekly cost of £13.25. We are currently with AIP catering who are always trying their best to keep cost as low as the possibly can.

We ask if you child would like to be on school dinner that all orders are updated on the school food united app. If you child is in moving in to KS2 there will be charges for school dinner as they are no longer eligible for universal meals

If your child is absent from school, you must cancel your child's meal on the school food united app.



If your child your child has an allergy the catering team will need you to pop in to the canteen as soon as possible to go through your child's new menus for September. The Catering team are available in the morning, the entrance is in the KS2 playground and up in the larks & owls entrance door
