



In case of an emergency, we require, at least 2 contacts to be added, we also require email addresses and the correct home address. All Parents should have received an email reminder to do this. If you are in YR or Y1 you will have received an email invitation asking you to register your account. This will now be in place of the paper data collection sheets. It is highly important that we hold the correct information at school therefore we expect all parents to activate their account.
