

This week's Mission:

Holy Week

In this last week of term, we remembered Holy Week. We walked with Jesus as we recalled the final days of His life. We had an assembly every day and each year group led us in a different event.

YR and Y1 reflected on how it begins with Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, singing 'Hosanna, King of Kings' and waving palms. Then Jesus directing the Disciples to set up the upper room ready for the Last Supper.







<u>Y2</u> reflected on Tuesday when Jesus got angry and cleared out the sellers in the temple. The Scribes and the pharisees did not like this. They wanted him to die and plotted against him. Then on to Spy Wednesday when Judas Iscariot decides to betray Jesus for 30 pieces of silver.

<u>Y3</u> led us through Maundy Thursday where Jesus washed the Disciples feet, then sat down with them to break the bread and drink the wine.

<u>Y4</u> took us to the Garden of Gethsemane and reminded us that Jesus prayed the Lord's prayer - the 'Our Father' for the first time while the Disciples fell asleep. They then acted out Juda betraying Jesus with a Kiss and his arrest.

Y5CW ended our week with Good Friday when the children led us reverently and beautifully in a dramatisation of the Stations of the Cross from Mary's story. It was a very moving experience for all the children. We now look forward to the joy of the Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

A message from the School Council MAD HAIR DAY

As representatives of the school council, we would like to bring to your attention an issue that has been affecting our learning environments at school. During our recent meetings, we have discussed the need for new blinds in our classrooms as the current ones are no longer functional and are hindering our ability to see our interactive white boards. This makes it difficult for us to follow along and complete our work and has become a daily frustration to us, especially when it is a sunny day. As a school, we strive for excellence, and we believe that it is crucial to achieve our goal to replace the blinds. Y4 have started collecting quotes and so far, we have been quoted between £1000 and £1700 PER



CLASSROOM (and we have at least 6 classrooms in urgent need). We understand that this is a significant amount and that the school budget will not stretch this far so we have decided to take matters into our own hands and raise funds for the blinds ourselves.

Our first fundraising day is a MAD HAIR DAY on Monday 15th April. We are asking for a minimum of £2 per pupil for this, however we understand that these are challenging times therefore any contribution would be highly appreciated.


Netball Update

We seek to work in conjunction with the local communities in which we operate and endeavour to gain their support in respect of our development operations. As we are due to commence construction work at the above site, we wish to emphasise that the work will include excavations and other operations of a nature whereby children playing on or around the site could be injured.

Due to the inherent dangers associated with construction sites, warning notices will be placed around the site and security fencing will fully enclose any dangerous activity. We do not allow children or anybody else at any time to come onto the site for play or any other purpose not connected with the company's operations.

This letter is written to enlist your support and co-operation in attempt to prevent the possibility of accidents to children arising out of their unauthorised presence on site. We encourage local authorities to alert schools in the vicinity of our developments to the possible dangers and obtain their co-operation in keeping school children away from the site. Where appropriate, we would be pleased to visit the local schools and speak to the children or arrange for a visit to the site.

Phase 1 site occupation commenced on 6 July 2020 and phase 2 commenced on 4 March 2024 which will continue for approximately 3 years. Our Site Manager for the development will be Julian Foster and any communication regarding the aforementioned should be addressed to him in the first instance. If you require any further information, please do not hesitate to contact us.
