Winter Uniform

The weather has now become more autumnal; therefore, <u>ALL</u> children should now be wearing their winter school uniform from next week (Monday 29th September).

This consists of a white collared shirt/blouse with a school tie, not a polo shirt. Grey, skirts/trousers and Girls should be in grey tights — NOT black.

Please make sure all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name and class. Children must still wear their coats to school on their PE days. 
