

School Meals – September 2023

Over this academic year Mrs Blundell has worked very hard to maintain the high level of lunchtime service she provides whilst facing the issue of rapidly rising food prices. Due to increased costs it has become necessary to increase the price of school meals from the start of the new academic year. From September 2023, school meals will be priced at £2.50 per day, £12.50 per week. This is the first price rise for school meals in over 3 years.

The final parts of the decarbonisation project will take place prior to the start of the new academic year. New windows and external doors will be fitted to improve insulation across school with this work due to commence on Monday 26th June.

I am delighted to announce that, following a successful bid to Blackburn Diocese, work will start on an extension to the current staffroom during the summer. This work will mean that from October half term we should have a new Key Stage 2 classroom in this extended space meaning that the staffroom and classes can be relocated accordingly. As we prepare for the start of a new school year in September we will be involving the children in a number of transition activities to give them the opportunity to get to know their classroom surroundings, teachers and support staff. Part of this work will involve transition afternoons on 28th June and 5th July.
