Every year each class also receives £300 enrichment fund from FoWE. Activities funded or subsidised this year include the chick incubator (nursery), Ark Farm and Ashridge (Reception), Senses workshop and HOTP Fire of London (Yr 1), HOTP Florence and Toys (Yr2), Stone Age/Viking School and Verulamium (Yr3), Cathedral and HOTP Vikings (Yr4), Lee Valley (Yr5) and Mayan workshop (yr6).



#### **Summer Reading Challenge**

The Summer Reading Challenge in Hertfordshire Libraries starts this Saturday, the theme this year is 'Gadgeteers', administered by the Reading Agency. Last year over 13,000 Hertfordshire children took part in the challenge, so do not miss out!

There are stickers to collect along the way and children who complete the challenge by reading, sharing, or listening to 6 library books (eBooks and eAudiobooks from BorrowBox count too!) and chatting to library staff or volunteers about them will be rewarded with a medal, pencil and certificate. Children who complete the Challenge will be entered into a prize draw where they could win a ticket to an exclusive author event at Welwyn Garden City Central Library on Sunday 25 September.

The Summer Reading Challenge's aim is to encouraging children to enjoy reading for pleasure and provides families with a fun, FREE activity for the long summer holidays. There is also a dedicated Summer Reading Challenge website <a href="Summer Reading Challenge">Summer Reading Challenge</a> which has a great range of themed games and activities, as well as the opportunity to read about favourite authors and contribute book reviews.

'Gadgeteers' packs will be available in all Hertfordshire libraries, from Saturday 9 July until Saturday 3 September 2022, while stocks last!
