Seat booking not required for Nursery, Year 3 and Year 6

We are using Arbor software to allocate seats for the Christmas performances for all other year groups. Under 'Trips' you will be able to see two dates/times for your child's Christmas performance.

To reduce numbers at each event, we can only offer a maximum of 2 seats per family. Either two seats for one performance or one seat for each.

IMPORTANT to book please follow these instructions:

Select <u>ONLY ONE date for 2 seats</u> for that performance (leave other date <u>blank</u>)

Select BOTH dates for ONE seat at each performance.

The system opens **Monday 14th November**, and will close **on Friday 25th November**. In the event of spare seats, these will be distributed after the initial 2 tickets per family have been allocated. If you would like an extra ticket, please **speak to/telephone the school office** (not email).

A programme will be emailed to you separately, before the performance for you to keep (not required for entry). If you do not have access to the internet, or if you are a parent/carer that does not live at the same address as your child, please contact the school office who will be happy to book seats on your behalf.
