Bullying V Banter

Through assemblies over the past few weeks we have been looking at our understanding of bullying and banter. Hammerhead have contributed well to our assemblies, helping us to understand what banter is and what it is not, in order to support everyone's understanding. Today we listened to an account through BBC Bitesize of a child's experiences of bullying which helped us understand the different forms bullying can take and the impact this can have. We have begun to explore what the pupils can do if they experience bullying and also what they should do if they see bullying. We will support pupils with providing details of charities to support with further information and contact. These will also be included in a Weekly Update to you.
