He was held back for two minutes while he was assessed, giving the rest of the drivers enough time to get a full lap ahead. Despite this huge setback, Artyn drove his heart out. Staying focused on his racing line and speed, he managed to catch the pack and overtake three karts. He then pushed even harder in the final, climbing the order and finishing in an impressive 5th place. Artyn has now completed all nine rounds and finished the championship 5th overall, an incredible achievement for his very first season! Having only started racing at the beginning of the year, he has progressed rapidly, learning racing lines, braking points, and where to go flat out. He has been fearless, hitting speeds of up to 50 mph, and has shown true sportsmanship by always bouncing back from setbacks like lost places or mechanical failures. Well done Artyn!
