This week, Year 5 have been blending pastels to create planets from our solar system and beyond!



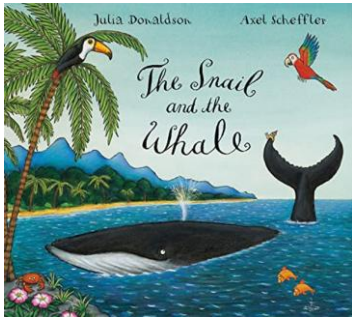
Christmas Cards
