Dear Parents and Carers,

This is a gentle reminder to please ensure your child comes to school each day with the correct equipment needed for their lessons. At present, many children are bringing a variety of extra stationery items and “bits and bobs”, but are missing some of the essential items they need for everyday learning.

All children should bring their own resources in a clearly named pencil case. This helps us to encourage independence, organisation and good preparation for learning.

Please also remind your child that they are responsible for looking after their own belongings, as we are unable to take responsibility for any items that are lost or damaged. For this reason, we recommend providing inexpensive items where possible, to avoid disappointment.

Stores such as Poundland or Asda are useful places to purchase suitable stationery.

Your child will therefore need the following equipment:

Year 4 equipment list

- Pencil x 3 every half term (18 in total)
- Green pens (1 every half term)
- Rubber x 3
- Sharpener x 1
- Coloured pencils x 1 pack
- Long ruler (30 cm) x 1
- Felt tips x 1
- **Whiteboard pen** (dry wipe) x 6 (1 every half term) **NB!**
- Glue stick x 6 (1 every half term)
- Dictionary x 1

Additionally, reading every day is extremely important. We ask that children read at home for at least 30 minutes every day. Daily reading has a huge impact on confidence, comprehension and overall progress in school, and your support with this is vital.

Lastly, please continue to encourage your child to practise their times tables regularly at home. The Multiplication Tables Check will take place during the two-week period between Monday 1 June and Friday 12 June 2026, and regular short practice makes a big difference. A very well done to the children in our class who are already confident with their times tables up to 12. We are very proud of their effort and progress. Their names are proudly displayed on our class *Star Wall*.
